Dear President Singletary:

The tabulation of votes cast in the election of a faculty representative to the Board of Trustees has been completed. This election was conducted to fill the vacancy created by the expiration of the term of Professor Constance P. Wilson as of June 30, 1981.

Professor Constance P. Wilson, College of Social Professions, has been re-elected to a three-year term beginning July 1, 1981 and ending June 30, 1984.

Of the 1,587 ballots sent out, 578 (36%) responded to the nomination ballot and the following six persons received the highest number of votes:

Harry M. Caudill (380 votes)
Constance P. Wilson (245 votes)
George W. Schwert (47 votes)
Bobby C. Pass (46 votes)
Robert W. Rudd (27 votes)
Daniel R. Reedy (20 votes)

These names were placed on the first election ballot.

Nine hundred thirty (59%) responded to the first election ballot. Professor Harry M. Caudill (359 votes), Professor Constance P. Wilson (269 votes), and Professor George W. Schwert (135 votes) received the highest number of votes without being elected and were placed on the second election ballot.

Nine hundred fifty (60%) responded to this ballot. Professor Caudill (426 votes) and Professor Wilson (319 votes) received the highest number of votes without being elected and were placed on the third election ballot.

Nine hundred seventy-five (61%) responded to the final ballot. Professor Wilson received 506 votes and Professor Caudill received 469 votes, thus giving Professor Constance P. Wilson the necessary majority.

I am sure you will wish to notify Professor Wilson of her election.
