Dear Dr. Wethington:

The tabulation of votes cast in the election of a faculty representative to the Board of Trustees has been completed. Professor Carolyn S. Bratt of the College of Law has been elected to a three-year term beginning on July 1, 1990, and extending until June 30, 1993.

The history of the balloting is as follows. On the nominating ballot, the following seven faculty members received the highest number of votes:
