Dear President Wethington:

The tabulation of votes cast in the election of a faculty representative to the Board of Trustees has been completed. Professor Daniel R. Reedy of the College of Arts and Sciences has been elected to a one-year term beginning on April 16, 1997, and extending until June 30, 1998.

The history of the balloting is as follows. On the nominating ballot, the following six faculty members received the highest number of votes (weighted as specified in the rules):


Donald T. Frazier (20 votes)	Daniel R. Reedy (102 votes)
