## Dear President Todd:

As Chair of the University Senate's Rules and Elections Committee, I oversee the election for faculty members of the Board of Trustees. On Monday, February 18<sup>th</sup>, the committee counted the ballots for the faculty member whose term will begin on July 1, 2002, and expire on June 30, 2005. Dr. Loys Mather currently holds this position and did not seek reelection.

Four faculty members were nominated pursuant to Senate Rule 1.5.2, which governs the election process: Bill Fortune (Law), Davy Jones (the Graduate School), Michael Kennedy (Arts & Sciences), and Judith Lesnaw (Arts & Sciences). The rule requires two ballots if there are more than three candidates. Dr. Lesnaw received the fewest votes on the first ballot and the remaining candidates appeared on the second ballot.
