

ROLE OF FACULTY IN REVIEW AND POLICY CHANGE

Review: Committee on Privilege and Tenure

As you well know, the faculty operates through the University Senate as set forth in the Governing Regulations. The President as chairman of this body may cause to be nominated, after consultation with and recommendation by the Senate Council, faculty members to various committees whose role is advisory, such as Area Advisory Committees. Another of the very important committees is the Committee* on Privilege and Tenure appointed by the President upon the recommendation of the Senate Council. I urged the establishment of such a Senate committee not only to formalize the tenure hearing procedure but also to assure non-tenure faculty opportunity for hearings if they felt their privileges as stated in regulation and policy had been abrogated.

Appendix H sets forth certain policies and procedures which have been proposed to permit implementation of the role of this committee as set forth in the following charge:

"The Committee on Privilege and Tenure will consider matters that are referred to it by the President, the University Faculty (now University Senate), or individual staff members of the University. The President
