Dear Doctor Willard:

In response to the recommendation contained in your letter of November 20, 1969, I wish to indicate that the Academic Advisory Area Committee of the Clinical Sciences for Medicine and Dentistry is hereby renamed the Medical Center Clinical Sciences and Special Title Series Area Committee.

This newly-structured committee will, in addition to its function in relation to the clinical faculty of the Colleges of Medicine and Dentistry, consider the proposed appointment, promotion, and tenure of the following:

Faculty of the College of Nursing  
Faculty of the Department of Clinical Pharmacy  
Faculty of the School of Allied Health Professions  
Other Faculty in the Special Title Series

I concur with your recommendation that membership on the committee include three faculty from the College of Medicine, two from the College of Dentistry, one each from the Colleges of Nursing, Pharmacy and School of Allied Health Professions.

In carrying out its functions, the committee is referred to criteria which exists for promotion and appointment of clinical faculties in Medicine and Dentistry, and approved criteria for faculty of the College of Nursing. It is my understanding that the document dated October 10, 1968 entitled "Medical Center Special Title Series," sets forth criteria which will apply in the case of other recommendations transmitted to the committee.

I call to your attention that membership on Area Committees is by Presidential appointment, from nominations transmitted from the Senate Council. I personally find the specific names which you recommended acceptable; however appointments will be deferred until the newly-constituted Senate Council has had an opportunity to present their recommendations. It is my suggestion that



Until formal appointments are made, it is assumed that the existing Clinical Sciences Area Committee will continue to function.
