A recent article in the New York Times by William Safire reported George Bush's advice to his cabinet at the beginning of his administration.

While our aims are somewhat more modest — I doubt if U.K. decisions are likely to have much effect on the Middle East — there may be some value in sharing Bush's hopes for his cabinet. I have listed the relevant points below, thinking they may be adaptable to our task at U.K.
