**Deadline for submission of abstracts: November 1, 2009**

The **Kentucky Foreign Language Conference** is proud to open sessions devoted to the presentation of scholarly research in the area of Peninsular Literature and Culture. Abstracts are invited in all areas and aspects of this field, including, but not limited to:

- Medieval Spanish literature
- Early Modern literature
- XVIII and XIX century literatures
- XX and XXI century literatures

Sessions are 20 minutes followed by a 10 minute questions & answer period. In addition to individual abstracts for paper presentations, proposals will be considered for complete panels of five papers organized around a common theme.

The KFLC has a tradition of attracting scholars from a broad range of languages and specializations. This year's conference will have sessions in Arabic, French, German-Austrian-Swiss, Russian, Italian, Luso-Afro-Brazilian, Language Technology, Second Language Acquisition, as well as Hispanic Studies and Hispanic Linguistics. Abstracts should be submitted electronically at <http://www.kflcabstracts.uky.edu/> Panel proposals should include the theme of the panel and the organizer's name at the bottom of each individually-submitted abstract. Papers may be read in English or Spanish.

**Deadline for submission of abstracts and panel proposals is 1 November 2009.**

Acceptance of a paper or complete panel implies a commitment on the part of participants to register and attend the conference. All presenters must pay the appropriate registration fee by 15 February 2010 to be included in the program.
