The KFLC provides a collegial atmosphere in which to present new research, confer with colleagues, and explore new topics, and join sessions in Arabic, French, German, Hispanic Studies, Language Pedagogy/Technology, and Luso-Brazilian. The KFLC is truly cross-cultural and cross-disciplinary.

The Russian Studies program in the Department of Modern & Classical Languages, Literatures, & Cultures of the University of Kentucky invites proposals for papers on a variety of topics in the areas of Russian/Slavic Language, Literature, Linguistics, Pedagogy, Folklore, and Culture. Past panels have included sessions on Russian language pedagogy, Russian teaching materials, 19<sup>th</sup> century Russian literature, 20<sup>th</sup> century Russian & Soviet Literature, Slavic Linguistics, and Russian music to name just a few.

Since the theme of this year's KFLC is "Gender Studies" we also encourage submissions on feminism/gender/women's studies in the Russian/Slavic field. In conjunction with the conference theme, the Russian Studies section will be holding a special session on Friday 16 April during which Professor Beth Holmgren, Duke University, will be discussing the evolution of women's studies in Russia and the US. In addition, she will be showing a film that features some of the most prominent Russian and US scholars on feminism, women's and gender studies. Thus, we welcome panels and abstracts on this topic.
